

Here are some details about the curriculum we will be teaching until Christmas.

Curriculum

Spring A - Children through History

Our written work will be based on the book Street Child by Berlie Doherty. We will be looking at narrative writing, as well as writing to persuade. In science, we will be studying light and how we see things and this will link with our artwork based on photomontages.

Spring B - It's Electrifying

Throughout this half-term, we are going to learn about electricity in more detail and use this to support our design and technology work based on building an electrical prototype. In maths, we will learn about geometry and our class story will be Letters From The Lighthouse by Emma Carroll.

PE, Drama and Computing

Physical education will be taught every week on a Monday morning by our PE coach. Drama and Computing will also be taught fortnightly by our specialist teachers.

Reading

Children are expected to read at home at least three times a week. This should be recorded in their yellow Reading Record, then signed and dated by an adult.
